ST. THERESA OF LISIEUX has been called:

4) **ST. THERESA, DOCTOR OF THE CHURCH**

The young nun's autobiography, *“The Story of a Soul”* presented people with a compelling example of spiritual maturity and piety achieved by an ordinary, young girl. This bestseller has been translated into more than sixty languages. Her letters, poems, prayers, and the plays she wrote for the monastery have also been published.

- She was canonized by Pope Pius XI on May 17, 1925.
- On October 19, 1997, Pope John Paul II declared her a Doctor of the Church, in tribute to the powerful way her spirituality has influenced people all over the world.
- She is the third woman to be named Doctor of the Church, following St. Catherine of Siena and St. Teresa of Avila.
- St. Theresa died at the age of 24, becoming the youngest Doctor of the Church.

Her Feast is celebrated on October 1st.
