## ST. PHOEBE CELEBRATION

The feast day of St. Phoebe will be recognized and celebrated again this year at the Masses on the weekend of September 1. St. Phoebe was a minister of a house church in Cenchreae, Greece in the early years of the Church. We learn about St. Phoebe in St. Paul's Letter to the Romans where he entrusts to St. Phoebe his letter to be delivered to the Christian community in Rome. He writes, "I commend to you Phoebe our sister, who is a deacon at the Church at Cenchreae, that you may receive her in the Lord in a manner worthy of the holy ones, and help her in whatever she may need from you, for she has been a benefactor to many and to me as well." (Romans 16:1-2).

St. Phoebe's prominent role in the early Church is an inspiration for all women to aspire to active participation in Church ministry.

Our celebration will include prayer and reflection on St. Phoebe during the Masses. A gathering for light refreshments and conversation will be held after the 10:30 Mass. All are welcome
