Kingdom of God and Kingdom of Heaven are phrases that represent the same meaning. Neither is used in the Old Testament [OT]. For a devout Jew, the word "God" is far too sacred to be used lightly and frequently. Matthew in the New Testament [NT], writing primarily to the Jews prescribed Kingdom of Heaven whereas Mark and Luke used Kingdom of God for non-Jews to understand. These phrases are at the core of Jesus' teaching. He never defined Kingdom of God territorially. He discarded any temporal dimension when he told Pilot "my kingdom is not of this world."
