### INDIGENEOUS RECONCILIATION FUND

Many thanks to the parishioners of St. Theresa Parish who donated \$1,810 to help defray the cost of the Pope's visit to Canada in July 2022. Your generosity is greatly appreciated.

In January 2022, Canada's Catholic Bishops agreed to establish a new registered charity to support and advance healing and reconciliation initiatives. The charity is expected to manage the Indigenous Reconciliation Fund, which will accept contributions from 73 dioceses across Canada in order to fulfill the \$30 million financial commitment made by Canada's Bishops in September 2021. To-date St. Theresa Parish has collected \$3,500 for this initiative. More details to come.
