"ENLARGE THE SPACE OF YOUR TENT" ANNA, THE PROPHETESS

Anna is mentioned in the Bible as a prophetess and one of the people connected to Jesus' childhood. Anna was the daughter of Phanuel of the tribe of Asher. All we know of her is found in three verses in the Gospel of Luke.

"And there was a prophetess, Anna. She was very old; she had lived with her husband seven years after her marriage, and then was a widow until she was eighty-four. She never left the temple but worshiped night and day, fasting and praying. Coming up to them at that very moment she gave thanks to God and spoke about the child to all who were looking forward to the redemption of Jerusalem" (Luke 2:36 -38).

Anna made her greatest contribution at an advanced age and after a lifetime of faithful service. Anna, the prophetess, knew by her encounter with the Christ Child that redemption was at hand and she couldn't contain her enthusiasm. Anna believed, thanked God and shared her joy with everyone. The Messiah had come and Anna was one of the first to know who He was. As one of the very first witnesses this aged woman significantly helped root the story of Jesus in the soil of Jewish history, its ancestors, prophecies and struggles.

Anna is the only named female prophet in the New Testament. Anna's experience shows us that God always gives an opportunity for gratitude and that age is of no consequence to God.
