In early December 2019, sloping window well covers were installed along the south side of the church to direct the snow away from the foundation and guard against water infiltration in the basement. If there is no sign of water infiltration, we will look into following up with a similar project on the north side. As well, we will look into painting the interior of the church. It is also anticipated that the repairs and renovations of our parking lot, originally slated for last summer, will go ahead this summer.
