"ENLARGE THE SPACE OF YOUR TENT"

MARIAM – SISTER, PROPHETESS, TEACHER

As the sister of Moses and Aaron, Mariam first appears in the Bible in Exodus 2 as an unnamed young girl. The Pharaoh feared the Israelites' growing population and ordered the Egyptians to throw any newborn Hebrew boy into the Nile River. Moses' parents hid him in a basket in the reeds of the Nile River. Miriam watched over him. When he was pulled out of the river by the Pharaoh's daughter, Mariam offered her mother as a nursemaid for Moses ensuring his mother's continued involvement in his life.

In Exodus 15, Moses parted the Red Sea allowing the Israelites to cross safely. He then restored the sea to its normal level killing the Egyptian army. Moses and the Israelites gave thanks to the Lord singing “I will sing to the Lord, for he is gloriously triumphant; horse and chariot he has cast into the sea. Mariam, the Prophetess, taught the women this song while playing their tambourines.

In Numbers 12, Mariam and Aaron questioned Moses' authority and claimed that God also used the two of them to speak to the Israelite people. God was not pleased and disciplined Mariam by striking her with leprosy. Aaron and Mariam asked for forgiveness while Moses prayed for her. Separated from the people for seven days, Mariam was then cured.
