PHYSICIAN-ASSISTED SUICIDE

CCCB: During their 2015 Plenary Assembly, the Bishops of Canada expressed "outrage at the decision of the Supreme Court of Canada to create a new 'constitutional right' in Canada, the so-called 'right' to suicide." They also expressed "profound dismay, disappointment and disagreement with the Court's decision. The ruling would legalize an action that, from time immemorial, has been judged immoral: the taking of innocent life. Moreover, it puts at risk the lives of the vulnerable, the depressed, those with physical or mental illness, and those with disabilities." Further info: (<http://www.cccb.ca>).

EXCERPT FROM POPE FRANCIS' HOMILY IN PHILADELPHIA LAST WEEKEND
