The Indigenous Reconciliation Fund was established by the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops late last year. The Bishops committed to raising \$30 million over five years from the 73 dioceses across Canada, to support and advance healing and reconciliation initiatives for residential school survivors and their families.
