God's Rule also demands our whole-hearted obedience to Him. We do not build His kingdom, we seek it: "seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things shall be yours" [Mt, 6:33]. Then we enter: "it is better for you to enter the kingdom of God with one eye..." [Mk, 9:47]. In essence, to enter the kingdom of God, we have to have the unquestioning obedience of a child: "Truly I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God like a child shall not enter it" [Mk, 10:15]. Absolute obedience is absolutely necessary to enter the kingdom of God.
