SOCIAL COMMITTEE

The Social Committee met on Sunday, October 24th. There are 2 main functions of our new Committee namely: a) Outreach and b) Functions/ Events. Outreach will consist of reaching out to Parishioners who are unable to attend church as well as contacting various relevant Organizations and Persons in need of help. Functions / Events will be designed to bring parishioners together to have fun.

A small group of people who have been liaising with Catholic Immigration Services focusing on helping Refugee Children. The Catholic Centre for Immigrants will be preparing Christmas hampers for Ukrainian families. Our role will be to provide gifts for the children/family to be included in these hampers. More news will be detailed soon.

We hope to work closely with the Centretown Churches Social Action Committee and the needs of the Centretown Emergency Food Centre. We hope to provide the parish with a list of items urgently needed by the Food Centre. A basket will be provided at the rear of the church for the collection of non-perishable food items.

Another outreach activity is the recently initiated monthly Senior's Tea which will close on 17 Nov and restart in April. It is hoped that our parish can organize and train a small group of volunteers to visit and or call area parish seniors at home and in nearby seniors' residences. Volunteers are welcome to join us once we begin this new outreach.

Closer to home we hope to fund raise for the East coast provinces that were devas tingly hit by Hurricane Fiona. A "Down East" social is being planned for February with funds going to the Red Cross. The Red Cross will match funds that we raise.

Pentecost 2023 will be a special time next year as we hope to welcome the parish and guests to a special multicultural potluck.

A large monthly calendar will be displayed for all groups to list their planned activities for the parish. This will eliminate any conflicts and also inform the parish of future dates to keep in mind.

It was agreed that the committee would meet monthly after Sunday Mass and that the next meeting would be held Nov. 13, 2022. Everyone is welcome to join us, many hands make light work.
